

Diamonds Site Randomisation Guideline

1. WHO?

Site staff delegated '5- Recruitment/Registration/Randomisation of Patients' on the delegation log and who have been trained on this guideline may randomise patients using the Sealed Envelope randomisation system either online or by telephone.

2. How?

NICTU will provide appropriately trained and delegated staff with a username and password for online login. Additionally, an investigator number will be provided to staff to enable telephone randomisation.

New Staff: To request a new user login, an email detailing site name, full name, type of account (notification only or investigator account) and email address of all new members of staff, should be sent to <u>DIAMONDS@nictu.hscni.net</u> when new site staff have completed appropriate training. Those with investigator accounts must be delegated '5- Recruitment/registration of Patients' on the delegation log. Please remember to forward a copy of any updated training and delegation logs to the NICTU. Please note that access will only be provided to users with an NHS email account unless otherwise agreed with the trial team.

3. ONLINE LOGIN AND RANDOMISATION

- Delegated site staff will be provided with individual login details. It is important to keep your username and password confidential at all times
- Please ensure your internet browser is enabled for Internet Explorer v8 or above
- Enter the Sealed Envelope website using the URL: https://www.sealedenvelope.com/redpill/diamonds
- Users are required to login with their given username and password

3.1 Online Randomisation

(a) To Randomise a Patient

- Select 'Randomise'
- Complete the randomisation page with the following information:
 - Patient's initials (N.B. Two initials only)
 - Date of birth
 - Screening number (SXXXXXX)
 - BCdVA in the study eye at presentation
 - Previous use of anti-VEGF therapies in the study eye
 - Previous laser therapy to the macula in the study eye
 - Has the eligibility checklist been completed and the patient been confirmed as eligible for recruitment?
 - Please confirm that eligibility assessments have been recorded?
 - Has written informed consent been obtained?

- Please give date written informed consent was obtained
- Site
- Select randomise
- To generate a randomised allocation, you must enter your password again and click on the 'confirm' button

(b) Confirmation/Notification Email

(c) Randomised in Error

A randomisation error may occur through duplication or input of incorrect data. If an error becomes apparent please do the following:

- Select 'Randomisations'
- Select the relevant Patient ID
- Select 'Create a new query'
- If the query is related to details entered on the randomisation form, select 'Study entry-Randomisation' from the drop down
- Choose the related question from the drop down as shown below In the 'title' field, provide a short description of the query

(iv) General Query

- Select 'Randomisations'
- Select the relevant subject ID
- Create a new Query If the query is not related to the randomisation form, select general query.
- Enter Text in message box
- Click 'create query'
- Please notify the DIAMONDS team by email <u>DIAMONDS@nictu.hscni.net</u> and an administrator at the NICTU will aim to action the query within two working days.

3.2 To View the Randomisation List

• Click 'Randomisations' to review the list of patients randomised at site.

3.3 To Create a Query or add information

• Any additional information, queries or notice of error can be entered in the notes section.

4. **TELEPHONE RANDOMISATION**

- Delegated site staff will be provided with an investigator number to access telephone randomisation. It is important to keep your investigator number confidential at all times.
- Log in details can be entered using a touchtone telephone.

- Enter study number
- Enter investigator number (3 digits)
- Enter patient DOB day (2-digits)
- Enter patient DOB month (2-digits)
- Enter patient DOB year (4-digits)
- Press 1 to continue or 2 to change your response
- Enter patient screening number (NB. Only enter numerical digits)
- Press 1 to continue or 2 to change your response
- BCdVA in the study eye at presentation
- Press 1 for ≥ 69 ETDRS letters, press 2 for 24-68 ETDRS letters
- Press 1 to continue or 2 to change your response
- Previous use of anti-VEGF therapies in the study eye

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- Press 1 for yes or 2 for no
- Previous laser therapy to the macula in the study eye
- Press 1 for yes or 2 for no
- Has the eligibility checklist been completed, and the patient been confirmed as eligible for recruitment?
- Press 1 for yes or 2 for no
- Please confirm that eligibility assessments have been recorded?
- Press 1 for yes or 2 for no
- Has written informed consent been obtained?
- Press 1 for yes or 2 for no
- Enter Date of Consent day (2-digits)
- Enter Date of Consent month (2-digits)
- Enter Date of Consent year (4-digits)
- Press 1 to continue or press 2 to change your response
- The subject was randomised to <treatment group> and randomised on <date> and is patient ID <RXXXXX>
- Press 1 to confirm you have recorded these details or press 2 to hear them again
- Hang-up
- You will receive an email confirming:

In the event of a known system outage, the NICTU will inform all sites of the outage. If both the online and telephone Sealed Envelope randomisation system is unavailable, the NICTU will request that no further randomisations are attempted at site until a further communication is sent. When the system is restored, NICTU will notify sites when randomisations can be performed.
