- Royal Gwent Hospital



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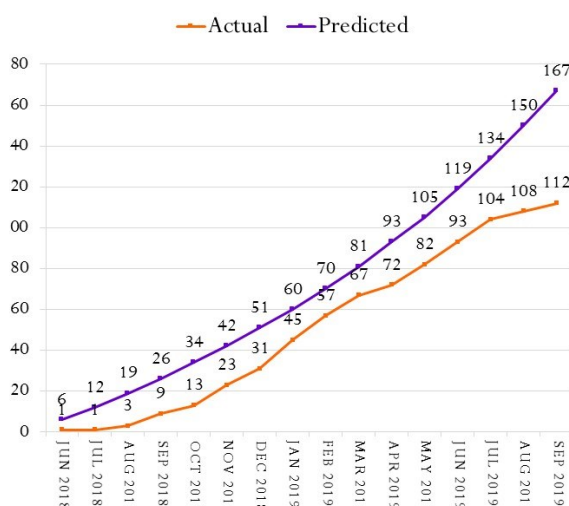
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STUDY UPDATE

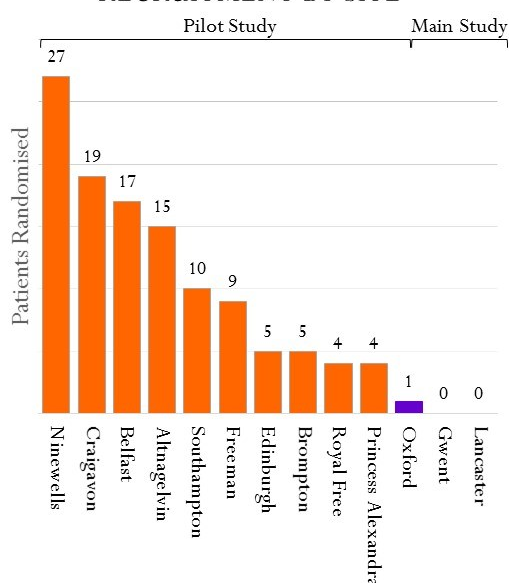
We'd like to say a big thank-you to all sites for your ongoing contributions to the study.
