MARCH Randomisation User Guide

Section 1: Getting Started

1. Before you begin, please make sure that you have been correctly set up on the randomisation system and you can access it in advance, so everything is ready before you randomise your first patient.

When you were added to the randomisation system, you should have received a username and password for the <u>MARCH</u> website. If you have not been registered on the system, or you have not received your login information, or you have any other issues, please contact the MARCH trial team by email at <u>march@nictu.hscni.net</u>

 To log in to the MARCH website (<u>https://w3.abdn.ac.uk/hsru/MARCH</u>) using your username and password. You will find those inside the email sent to you by the CHaRT support team. If you haven't received and email, please contact <u>march@nictu.hscni.net</u>. Type in your username and password and click on the 'Log In' button.

3. **Password Recovery**

You have the facility to request a new password. If you have forgotten your password, please click on the 'Forgot my password' link. A new window will pop up: You are asked to provide the E-mail address registered with your account and your username. When you are done, click on the 'Submit' button. A link to reset your password is sent to your registered email address. Follow the instructions to

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reset your password. Then try to login again.

4. Once you have logged in successfully, select "Randomisation" from the menu on the left. If you only see icons, you can expand the menu by clicking the 3 straight lines in the top left corner.



Please check you have access to the randomisation functionality in advance.

NB When you are first set up on the randomisation system, you will have an opportunity to use the test centre ID to practice a randomisation before your centre 'goes live.' Please contact the march team for further details.

Section 2: New Randomisation

- 1. Please select your centre name and number from the drop-down list. Please note in order to randomise the patient, the first two digits of the screening number must match the centre number.
- 2. Please enter the patients' initials using only two letters.
- 3. Please select the patient's gender using the dropdown box.
- 4. Please enter the patients age using the calendar or enter in the format DD/MM/YYYY including the '/'
- 5. Please enter the patient's screening number without the leading S. The screening number has six digits. The first two digits are your centre number for example 01; 09; 11 etc.
- 6. If the participant has been confirmed as eligible, please select 'yes' from the dropdown menu.
- 7. If informed consent has been obtained, please select 'yes' from the dropdown menu.
